**Groups for 1st through 3rd Grades:**

**4:30 - 5:30pm YMCA Classroom (check in at front desk inside front entrance)**

Activities will include facilitated group interaction, snack, arts & crafts, games, and group activities using the facilities (such as the gymnasium).

**Groups for 4th through 8th Grades:**

**6:30 - 8:00pm Teen Center (enter in the rear of the building at the Teen Center)**

Activities will include facilitated group interaction, snack, recreational activities in the Teen Center (foosball, pool tables, table games), and use of the gym.

**Fee:** \$10/group activity night, or \$25/session of three group activity nights (to cover program costs, materials and supplies)

**Location:** Hudson YMCA - 2211 Vine Street, Hudson WI

**Parent/Guardian Presence Required:** A parent or legal guardian must remain at the YMCA during the activities.

**Childcare:** Parents can contact WWAACC about childcare for siblings if needed.

**Youth requiring 1:1 assistance may have a caregiver accompany them.**
